Our study is a questionnaire based observational study with data collected from both orthopedic and plastic surgery hand surgeons at Yale New Haven Hospital. The questionnaire inquires about current practices and preferences regarding WALANT surgery, types of procedures performed in the office, preference on types of local anesthesia, reasons for choosing office based surgery versus not for simple hand procedures. Our study aims to elucidate some clinical and financial forces at work, including system based issues, coding, policy and patient preference for sedation.
